CLAREMONT NURSING & REHABILITATION CENTER TO CELEBRATE LAUNCH OF SHORT TERM REHAB PROJECT

Cumberland County, PA – The Claremont Nursing & Rehabilitation Center (CNRC) will celebrate the expansion of its rehabilitation care services during a short ceremony on Monday, April 21, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. at Claremont. The County-owned nursing facility is located at 1000 Claremont Road in Middlesex Township. The ceremony will mark the launch of the short-term rehab renovation project expected to be completed within 8-10 months. A new rehab wing will allow Claremont to admit short-term residents to one designated area that will more efficiently meet the needs of their conditions.

The nearly \$2.9 million renovation project will bring additional rehab services projected to increase CNRC's net revenues by approximately \$480,000 a year. The goal is to eliminate any potential taxpayer General Fund subsidy and assist with promoting the financial viability of the nursing home. In order to secure the future of this community-based, skilled nursing facility, CNRC must remain competitive. The new state-of-the-art rehab unit will facilitate that objective and benefit CNRC in its mission to provide therapeutic nursing care for residents with a variety of needs for many years to come.

CNRC has received a Five Star Rating from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS). Karen DeWoody, CNRC Administrator, stated that safeguards have been taken to ensure there are no operational impacts to the facility during the renovation process.
