

Miller graduates from Leadership Cumberland

Justin Miller, Recycling Coordinator for Cumberland County graduated from the 2019 class of Leadership Cumberland. A celebration was held on June 5th in the Holland Union Building at Dickinson College in Carlisle. Leadership Cumberland graduates presented their work and the impact of their projects.

Thirty-five individuals participated in this year's program, which lasted 10 months including a two-day retreat in September. The day-long classes addressed leadership skills, community service, networking, personal development, and knowledge of the county.



Cumberland County Household Hazardous Waste Program

The format for the County's Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) program has changed for 2019. The event will be spread over three separate days this year and residents will need to schedule a time during those days to drop off their material. Participants must sign up for an appointment in advance. Appointment slots are available in 15 minute increments and are limited to 12 customers per slot. In addition, a \$.30 / lb. fee will be charged.

Municipal Land Preservation Forum
