

FEMA to Host Open House

FEMA will be hosting an open house for Cumberland County residents and stakeholders to review and discuss the Preliminary Flood Rate Insurance Maps (FIRMs).

Staff from FEMA will be present to discuss the map preparation process, insurance implications and explain how residents can appeal new floodplain boundaries that they believe may be incorrect. County Planning staff will also be on hand to assist residents in viewing FIRM maps and the location of floodplain boundaries for specific properties.

The open house will be held on the evening of November 6, 2019. Residents can arrive any time between 5:00pm – 8:00pm, the open house will be located at 310 Allen Road (Conference Room B), Carlisle, PA 17013.

Cumberland County Household Hazardous Waste Program

The format for the County's Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) program has changed for 2019. The event will be spread over three separate days this year and residents will need to schedule a time during those days to drop off their material. Participants must sign up for an appointment in advance. Appointment slots are available in 15 minute increments and are limited to 12 customers per slot. In addition, a \$.30 / lb. fee will be charged.
