### **Four Residents Test Positive for COVID-19 at Claremont Nursing and Rehabilitation Center; All Visitation Has Ceased**

**Carlisle, PA** – Claremont Nursing and Rehabilitation Center (CNRC) today announced that four residents tested positive for COVID-19.

The residents, who tested positive this morning, are quarantined in their rooms. All residents and staff are being tested for the virus. Testing will continue weekly, until there are no positive cases. All families have been notified.

All visitation has ceased for the safety of the residents, staff and visitors, with the exception of end of life.

Since the pandemic began, twelve staffers and six residents have tested positive for the virus.

Claremont continues to follow CDC and Pennsylvania Department of Health's COVID-19 guidelines for its residents and employees.
