Call to Order: Commissioner Eichelberger called the meeting to order.

Roll Call: Commissioners Eichelberger, Foschi, and DiFilippo were present.

Public Comment: None.

Approval of Meeting Minutes: Commissioner Foschi made a motion to approve the minutes of February 8, 2021. Commissioner DiFilippo seconded the motion and the motion unanimously carried.

Approval of New Polling Locations: Bethany provided an overview of new polling locations:

- Cooke Township – Penn Township Volunteer Fire Co. 1750 Pine Rd., Newville
- Dickinson South – Uriah UMC, 925 Goodyear Rd., Gardners
- Mt. Holly Springs – Borough Building, 200 Harman St., Mt. Holly Springs
- Newburg – Newburg UMC, 203 N. High St., Newburg

Commissioner Foschi asked how residents receive notification of the new polling locations. Discussion ensued. Solicitor Hipp explained that Cooke Township is subject to approval by the Fire Co.

Commissioner Eichelberger made a motion to approve Cooke Township pending approval from the PTVFC. Commissioner Foschi seconded the motion and the motion unanimously carried

Commissioner Foschi made a motion to approve the new polling locations subject to the Department of Justice approval. Commissioner DiFilippo seconded the motion and the motion unanimously carried.

Approval of temporary polling location for Primary:

- Hampden 5/6 – Hampden Elementary, 441 Skyport Rd., Mechanicsburg

Bethany explained that due to construction at the middle school Hampden 5/6 moved temporarily to the elementary school for the Primary election.

Commissioner DiFilippo made a motion to approve the new temporary polling location subject to the Department of Justice approval. Commissioner Foschi seconded the motion and the motion unanimously carried.

Approval of temporary locations for 2021:

- Lower Allen 6 – Christian Life Assembly, 2645 Lisburn Rd., Camp Hill
- Upper Allen 7 – Municipal Building, 100 Gettysburg Pike, Mechanicsburg

Bethany explained that the continued concern of COVID restrictions prompted the need for temporary locations for 2021. Bethany mentioned that there is still no response from One West Penn. Solicitor Hipp emphasized that approval of all locations are subject to approval by the Department of Justice.

Commissioner Foschi made a motion to approve the temporary polling locations subject to Department of Justice approval. Commissioner DiFilippo seconded the motion and the motion unanimously carried.

Approval to submit these locations to the Department of Justice for Approval:

Commissioner DiFilippo made a motion to approve the submission of new permanent and temporary polling locations and forward to the Department of Justice for approval. Commissioner Foschi seconded the motion and the motion unanimously carried.

Adjourn: There being no further business to come before the Board, Commissioner Eichelberger made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Foschi seconded the motion.
