Cumberland County Public Safety Review Team Meeting

February 23, 2021 – 10:00 a.m.

Approval of Review Team Meeting Minutes: Commissioner Foschi made a motion to approve the minutes of January 26, 2021. Commissioner DiFilippo seconded the motion and it unanimously carried.

911 Operational Updates – John Quirk

Staffing and Personnel Updates:

John reported there were three new hires in February and two part-time staff persons in training. EFD certification classes continue.

Technical Systems Updates – Brian Hamilton, Molly Baker

P25 Radio Project:

Brian reported that Three Square was approved for site excavation with one condition related to native American presence. The Lambs Gap tower approval has not yet been received. The initial draft of site layouts has been completed but the final quote has not been received.

Hexagon CAD Project Update:

Molly explained that CAD Phase II items and enhancements continue. XALT developer training is completed. The Automated Secure Alarm Protocol is implemented and working. CAD to CAD routing of mutual aid calls continues with Dauphin County.

Emergency Management Updates – Michele Parsons

Michele gave an overview of COVID statistics for the month and vaccine updates. She reported that 590 COVID tests were administered during the community testing event. Michele specified that the FEMA mass vaccination clinic held in Philadelphia was a separate allocation and not part of Pennsylvania's allotment. She reported the team is focusing on the final plans for a Community Vaccination Clinic in the Carlisle area. Discussion ensued.

CISM Team updates – Mike Snyder

Mike reported 35 people are in training.

Fiscal Items: – Claudia Garner

Claudia explained they will be looking for subsidy as the 2020 expenses have met the revenue. Claudia mentioned that Connie Heckard will be retiring in April.

National Honor Guard: Claudia said the Guard took part in the funeral for Kenneth Fetrow. She explained how they utilized virtual platforms to participate.
