### **911 Operational Updates – Bob Shively**

#### Staffing and Personnel Updates:

Bob summarized training updates. He reported there were two employees in medical protocol training and one in certification class.

#### Fire and Police Protocol Implementation:

Bob reported fire did go live March 1<sup>st</sup>, and police runs through April with a go live date in June.

### **Technical Systems Updates – Brian Hamilton, Molly Baker**

#### P25 Radio Project: (Brian Hamilton)

Brian reported that P25 is still progressing as expected.

#### Hexagon CAD Project Update: (Molly Baker)

Molly reported CAD to CAD routing of mutual aid calls continues with Dauphin County.

### **Emergency Management Updates – Michele Parsons, Mike Snyder**

#### EMA Updates: (Michele Parsons)

Michele gave an overview of COVID statistics for the month and provided an update on vaccine availability. She reported the team is waiting for direction from the State as to what is expected from the County for Phase 1B in terms of vaccine availability. Michele expressed there is a need for training persons as weather spotters. She noted the LAPC summit will be held on October 21<sup>st</sup> at the Army Heritage Center.

#### CISM Team Updates: (Mike Snyder)

Mike reported that the next instruction sessions will be April 21 and 28, and information will be available via social media. First responders dealt with several fires recently.

**Fiscal Items – Claudia Garner**

Claudia indicated nothing is pending. She explained the website is set up but it is a work in progress. Claudia mentioned they are working with IMTO to develop a phone bank at the mass vaccination site.
