### **Topics of Discussion:**

**Discussion of the Cumberland County Housing and Redevelopment Authority 2021 Budget Update and 2022 Funding Request and Possible Motion to Approve the Cumberland County Housing and Redevelopment Authority 2022 Funding Request:** Rebecca Yearick summarized how the 2021 budget was utilized to improve various downtown areas within Cumberland County. She explained they provided support to local businesses, including restaurants and dance studios. She clarified that the businesses supported through these downtown program services were able to create and retain jobs within Cumberland County. She explained that the requested funding for 2022 is \$20,000, which is the same amount that was requested for 2021. Commissioner Foschi provided positive feedback on the work Rebecca has done in 2021. Commissioner Eichelberger shared that he is very pleased with the improvements being made through these services. Mary Kuna made a formal funding request of \$20,000 from Cumberland County to be used for community development and business services.

Commissioner Foschi made a motion to approve the Cumberland County Housing and Redevelopment Authority 2022 Funding Request of \$20,000 for community development and business services. Commissioner DiFilippo seconded the motion and the motion unanimously carried.
