Call to Order: Commissioner Foschi called the meeting to order.

Public Comment: None.

Approval of Minutes: Commissioner DiFilippo made a motion to approve the meeting minutes of May 11, 2022. Commissioner Foschi seconded the motion and it unanimously carried.

Topics of Discussion:

Discussion of the Statewide Detention Crisis and Regional Response: Andy Benner provided information on secure detention services and the essential level of care needed in Pennsylvania for high-risk youths. He explained that the level of care is currently not available due to centers closing and staffing issues. Andy discussed possible solutions to include a renovation of the county prison to accommodate beds as a juvenile detention center or contracting with a current provider to guarantee detention beds. Andy provided some statistics on the utilization of beds and financial impact when the beds are not utilized. More discussion ensued regarding Federal guidelines and the use of the prison.

Discussion and Possible Motion to Support Naming the Tributary to the Conodoguinet Creek in Camp Hill Borough Blackberry Spring Run: Kirk Stoner discussed the notice from the Board on Geographic Names (BGN) requesting comments from the county on naming an unknown tributary to the Conodoguinet Creek in Camp Hill. Kirk said this is a small creek contained in Seibert Memorial Park. Camp Hill Borough recommended approving that the name be Blackberry Spring Run. Kirk stated that he did look at the notice and has no problem recommending the name.

Commissioner DiFilippo made a motion to support Camp Hill Borough's Resolution 2022-4 Naming the Tributary to the Conodoguinet Creek in Camp Hill Borough to BlackBerry Spring Run. Commissioner Eichelberger seconded the motion and it unanimously carried.

Other Business:

- Kirk Stoner gave an update to the Commissioners regarding the Pennsylvania Broadband Authority's goal to have everyone at getting 100% internet overage throughout the state. He said

that he is working with Adam's County and Franklin County on the RFP and are going to try and coordinate with the Broadband Authority to work with the state.

- Commissioner Eichelberger reported that he received an email from the Commonwealth Court, and they have granted the injunction on the I-83 tolling project.

Adjourn: There being no other business to come before the board, Commissioner made a motion to adjourn.
