

## **2021 Farmer of the Year**

The Conservation District would like to congratulate Todd Rabert of RnR Farms in Monroe Township for becoming the 2021 Farmer of the Year. Todd has been farming for 42 years and is a 7<sup>th</sup> generation farmer. Todd owns two farms; both are preserved and total approximately 170 acres located on Williams Grove Road and South Locust Point Road. He rents roughly 393 total acres. Todd's farm on Williams Grove Road is a beef cattle operation, and the farm on South Locust Point is planned to have several broiler houses that will house a total of 139,200 birds. Todd has a Comprehensive Nutrient Management Plan (CNMP), which makes him compliant with the state requirements. He's working with Eric Rosenbaum from the 4R Alliance on a Nitrogen Modeling Pilot Project with Granular, to do some precision ag work. In addition to working on his farms and rented fields, he does some custom combining and grain hauling. Todd is a conscientious farmer and deserving of this award.
